## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### JKSET/LASET- 2023

SECTION – I :- General Questions		
Sl no	Questions	Answers
1	What is JKSET Agency?	The Higher Education Departments of UT of Jammu and Kashmir and UT of Ladakh have authorized the University of Jammu as a <b>Nodal Agency</b> (hereby called as JKSET Agency) to conduct the State Eligibility Test to determine the eligibility of the candidates for the post of Assistant Professor in the Universities and Colleges in the respective Union Territories. The University Grants Commission has further accredited the University of Jammu to hold State Eligibility Test for the UT of J & K (named as JKSET) and UT of Ladakh (named as LASET).
2	When will be the Online Application form for JKSET/LASET -2023 be available on website?	The Online Application form for JKSET/LASET -2023 will be available from 05-05-2023 to 04-06-2023 on the JKSET official website <a href="http://www.jukset.in">www.jukset.in</a> . or from University of Jammu website <a href="http://www.jammuuniversity.ac.in">www.jammuuniversity.ac.in</a> .
3	When will be the JKSET/LASET-2023 Examination be conducted?	JKSET/LASET- 2023 Examination will be conducted on 1 <sup>st</sup> October, 2023 (Sunday).
4	What will be the mode of examination? (offline or online)?	The JKSET/LASET-2023 shall be Paper & Pen based and conducted in Offline mode.
5	Is there any Negative Marking in the JKSET/LASET Examination	No
6	What is the syllabus for JKSET/LASET- 2023?	The Syllabi for JKSET/LASET-2023 will be the same as that of UGC/CSIR NET. Updated Syllabi for all SET subjects can be downloaded from the JKSET website <a href="http://www.jukset.in">www.jukset.in</a> . It is also available on CSIR HRDG website (for CSIR NET subject Areas i.e. Mathematical Sciences, Physical Sciences, Chemical Sciences, Life Sciences & Earth Sciences) <a href="http://www.csirhrdg.res.in">www.csirhrdg.res.in</a> .; for all other subjects it is also available at UGC website- <a href="https://www.ugcnetonline.in/syllabus-new.php">https://www.ugcnetonline.in/syllabus-new.php</a> .
7	What will be the examination pattern?	The scheme of examination for JKSET/LASET- 2023 shall be same as prescribed for UGC-NET conducted by the NTA. There shall be two papers in each subject. <b>Paper- I (General Paper)</b> shall consist of 50 objective type compulsory questions. <b>Paper-II (Subject)</b> shall consist of 100 objective type questions, which will be based on the subject selected by the candidate. For detailed pattern of examination please refer Information bulletin (page 9-10) available on JKSET website
8	My subject is not available in the list of the subjects for which JKSET is being held. What should I do?	The JKSET is being conducted for limited number of the subjects. For all other subjects, candidates are advised to appear in the UGC NET examinations which is being conducted twice a year.

9	Can I download the previous year question papers?	Yes, previous year question papers can be downloaded from the JKSET website.
10	What is the validity of the JKSET/LASET certificate?	The SET certificates are valid forever.
<b>SECTION – II :- ONLINE APPLICATION FORM</b>		
11	How to fill up ‘online’ application form for JKSET/LASET-2023?	Go to the official website of the JKSET and follow the steps given under the heading “How to Apply”. You may also find the details in the Information Bulletin (page no 8). Replica of Online Application process is also given as annex.
12	What should I do, if ‘continuous timeout’ or ‘file not found error’ occurs while filling online form of SET	Use good internet connection and good internet browser latest/and while filling application form. In case of continuous time out clear cookies and history of the browser and fill in off-peak hours.
13	Do I need to post the Printed Application form along with the other eligibility documents to JKSET Office?	Candidates need not to send hard copies of downloaded Application Form, Fee Receipt and eligibility documents etc in SET office through Post/Fax/By Hand before the examination. But they must keep copies of the Printed Application Form along with Payment Receipt at a safe place, as these are required to be submitted to JKSET office after they qualify the exam.
14	If mistakenly during filling up of the form, wrong particulars are filled in the online form, how it will be corrected.	Correction Window for 3 days shall be provided to the candidates to make corrections, if any, in few particulars only (like name, Parent’s name, DoB, address, e-mail id, %age of marks) as per schedule notified (9 <sup>th</sup> to 11 <sup>th</sup> June, 2023). No correction will be allowed thereafter. All the information (especially in category) which is filled on the date of submission of form will be considered valid and no change is allowed later.
15	Can I change my registered mobile no after the submission of application form.	The mobile no is a unique no for the candidates and will be used to log in along with the Payment transaction no every time. Hence it cannot be changed.
16	Can I change the examination center?	Examination Centre cannot be changed in any case.
17	Can I apply for multiple subjects in the JKSET exam?	No, you can apply only for one subject at a time in the JKSET/LASET. More than one application i.e. multiple Application Forms submitted by a candidate will not be accepted.
18	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for JKSET-2023?	Online Application forms once submitted successfully cannot be cancelled/ withdrawn.
19	I have passed my PG degree from an allied subject which is not being shown in the list of the PG subjects. What should I do?	Candidates are required to appear in the subject of their Post-Graduation only. The candidates whose post-graduation subject is not covered in the list of subjects in Table-2 may appear in UGC-NET/ UGC-CSIR Test held on regular basis.
20	If one does not get Admit Card, whom should he contact?	Admit cards will not be sent to candidates. These will be uploaded on website. Candidates need to download the Admit Card from the website only.
21	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
22	How will one know the result of the JKSET/LASET-2023?	JKSET/LASET– 2023 result will be uploaded on the JKSET website and shall be published in the newspapers too.

### SECTION – III :- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

23	I am studying in the 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester of my PG programme. Can I also apply for the JKSET exam?	Yes, you are eligible to appear in the exam. However, your admission shall be provisional only. You must qualify your P.G. degree examination within two years from the date of SET result with required percentage of marks, failing which you shall be treated as disqualified. (Refer page 4 of Information Bulletin).
24	I am from other than SC/ ST/ PwD category and have passed my Master's degree with 54.9% of marks. Am I eligible to appear in the JKSET exam?	No you are not eligible. As per the eligibility criteria mentioned at page no.4 of the Information Bulletin, Candidates who have secured minimum 55% marks (without rounding off) or an equivalent grade in point scale in Master's Degree from Universities/ Institutions recognized by UGC, are eligible for JKSET/LASET. However, Candidates belonging to Schedules Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST)/ Person with disability (PwD) Category must have passed their PG Degree with minimum 50% marks (without rounding off), or an equivalent grade in point scale to become eligible for appearing in the JKSET/LASET.
25	What is the age limit to apply for the JKSET/LASET	There is no upper age limit for applying to JKSET/LASET exam.
26	What is the reservation criteria for JKSET/LASET.	It is as per respective UT Reservation Policy.
27	How to remit Application/examination fee for JKSET/LASET-2023.	The Application/ Examination fee for JKSET/LASET can be remitted in online mode only in the following manner: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Through any Debit/Credit Card using on-line gateway payment facility or</li> <li>➤ Net Banking or</li> <li>➤ UPI</li> </ul>
28	Whether the application fee exclude the Service charge and GST?	Applicable service/processing charges & GST over and above the Examination Fee are to be paid by the candidate to the concerned Bank/ Payment Gateway Integrator. Service charges for the two payment gateways are different. The candidates must check the service charges before submission of the fee.
29	What to do in case of problem in remittance of fee due to failed transaction?	If the payment status of online transaction (by credit/debit card) is not communicated by payment gateway in real time, then fee payment is not completed and the candidate will not be able to get himself/herself registered or download the Application form. In this case, the candidate is required to pay fee again through online mode and complete the application process. The amount due to of failed transaction of credit/debit card will be refunded back within 7 to 10 days to the account.
30	If a candidate for any reason has not appeared in the examination, is there any provision for fee refund?	No. Once the provided online application form is submitted successfully by the candidate, it cannot be withdrawn. Claims for refund of application fee will not be entertained under any circumstances.
